

## **ARZA** By Charlie Niederman Association of Reform Zionists of America

Over the last year and a half these articles have frequently reported the lack of progress on the agreement reached in January 2016, to construct an egalitarian prayer area at the Kotel, the Western Wall, actually a retaining wall of the Temple mount. It was the result of protracted negotiations between the Ultra-Orthodox authority that administrates the Kotel, and the progressive groups that have pressed for an area where men and women can pray together. The negotiations were moderated by Natan Sharahsky, Chairman of the Executive of the Jewish Agency, who was appointed to the position by Prime Minister Netanyahu, and it was agreed to by the Israeli cabinet. This week the cabinet froze the plan. To add insult to injury the Knesset is considering a bill to declare that only Orthodox conversions conducted by the rabbis and courts under the Chief Rabbinate will be accepted by Israel. The actions provoked immediate disapproval by ARZA (Association of Reform Zionists of America). URJ (The Union for Reform Judaism) and many other Diaspora groups especially in North America, and by much of the Israeli press.

Israel's President Reuven Rivlin urged the government to prioritize the "unity of the Jewish people" and retain its role as the state for all Jews. "Our fellow Jews in the Diaspora have an important and significant role in the building of the State of Israel., The unity of the Jewish People must always remain an important aspiration of the governments of Israel."

The Anti Defamation League declared that the Kotel decision weakens the ties between Israel and American Jewry. ARZA declared, "ARZA condemns both of these outrageous actions which, if allowed to stand, will cement the power of the ultra-Orthodox minority in Israel at the expense of Jewish unity and pluralism, undermine religious freedom in the State of Israel, and open a schism between Israel and world Jewry."

ARZA declared that the Kotel agreement was a milestone for compromise and unity; and referred to Prime Minister Netanyahu's words, that the agreement "endorsed One Wall for One People".

They continued, "Some commentators have called these bills the trigger for American Jewry to abandon Israel. As the voice of Reform Zionism in America, we refuse this option: In fact, the reason for our outrage is precisely because of our movement's deep and unending commitment to Israel. We fear that the extremist ideology expressed in the government's action against the Kotel compromise and the conversion bill will drive Jews—especially the younger generation—away from Israel. We will continue to express our Zionist love for Israel by working for an Israel that reflects the vibrant tapestry of Jewish expression, free from religious coercion."

Let us hope that Prime Minister Netanyahu and the more moderate members of his cabinet listen to their President, and the voices in the Diaspora.




