Beth David Library Column

I am adding more books to the Beth David library. Cantor Jenna Sagan asked me to take all the children's books from Congregation B'nai Tzedek and add them to our library. I brought home 7 bankers' boxes of books. Most are for ages 1 – 8. There is one box of books for ages 9 – 11. They had no teenage books. So far, I have cataloged 50 books, and I have gone through 3 of the boxes. I anticipate there will be 150 – 200 new books added to our library. I took home about 20 adult books from their library. I left the rest of their adult library collection because I do not have room for the rest of their books.

Beth David now has about 1,000 children's books ages 1 – 8, 250 middle grade books ages 9 – 11, and 80 young adult books ages 12 – 17. The adult library has about 360 books. The reference collection in Rabbi Myers office has 94 books which includes Encyclopedia Judaica 2 nd edition published in 2007, and a 36-volume set of Talmud in English. The Orange County California Jewish Genealogy Societies Jewish Genealogy Library is in my garage library and has 224 Jewish Genealogy books.

To our congregants who spoke during the Mental Health Shabbat, you showed us what courage and authenticity look like by sharing your own mental health and wellness journey.

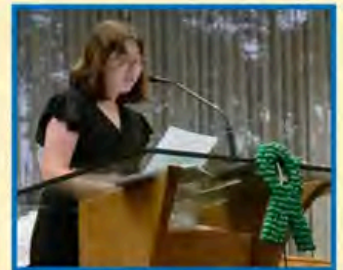
The reactions to the service and your words have all been positive. One said, "This was so important and one of the most moving and memorable Shabbat services."

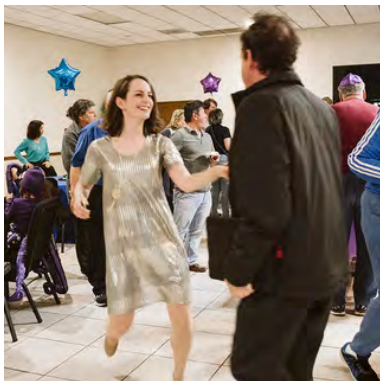
